1. Meeting declared open by the Chairman Mr. Peter Watson at 11am.
2. Minutes of the AGM held on the 3rd March 2004 were circulated and approved.
3. As the General Election was about to be held, the Chairman requested that the existing committee should remain unchanged. The members present voted and approved this. Additionally, it was also voted and approved that there would be an Extraordinary General Meeting as soon after the aforementioned General Election as could be arranged to address the question of the committee. The branch had become independent of Dorset West in August 2004, and this was therefore the inaugural AGM of Dorset North.
4. The Treasurer's Report was also postponed to the forthcoming EGM to allow more time for Election Business.

The Chairman reported on the efforts being made regarding passing information to the voters, in particular to leafleting to reinforce the message contained in the election address that was being sent to every household via the Royal Mail. He urged all present to do all they could to secure a victory in the election, and hoped to improve on the 7,000 in Dorset North who voted for UKIP in the European elections in June 2004. He then introduced The UKIP PPC Mr. Richard Frampton-Hobbs who was invited to address the meeting.
6. Mr. Frampton-Hobbs give a brief resume of his personal CV, especially in connection with farming and the military. He went on to speak of his election hopes and the wish to reverse the federalisation of the UK. He acknowledged the magnitude of the effort required to do so, encouraging those present to continue the campaign to the last minute. He answered questions from the floor.
7. There being no further business, the Chairman asked for people to leaflet the Blandford people outside the Town Hall after the meeting and closed the meeting a little after 12pm.
