Elsewhere Christchurch UKIP held the first **Westminster Hustings** in the county this time round. Around 55 people were present to see the three candidates fight it out to become the PPC for Christchurch. After good performances all round Robin Grey came out top. Robin previously came a very close second [by just 2 votes] in the County Council election in May for the St Leonards and St Ives division. We offer our congratulations to Robin, and commiserations to the other two candidates, Richard Turner and Philip Glover. All is not lost for these two candidates. They may well compete at another Hustings in Dorset. Watch this space!

On the subject of Hustings all the Dorset Branches will want to follow Christchurch and the two Poole constituency associations [see the diary] and **select their PPCs**. All need to find and encourage potential candidates to go through the UKIP assessment process so they can stand for their associations. If you are considering standing for Westminster Parliament in 2015 please contact your chairman to get the ball rolling. Time is passing very quickly and this action needs to be taken now.

We have now heard that UKIP **membership** has exceeded 30,000. This is a wonderful improvement on a year ago. We take this opportunity to welcome warmly those in Dorset who may be reading the Digest for the first time. We hope you find it interesting and a help to your membership. Do please try to attend at least some of the events – we try to be a sociable lot and don't bite! At least, not our friends.

It is not only membership which increasing. The number of **councillors** is also on the up, partially due to defections of those thoroughly fed up with the three failing parties such as the three in Rutland, but also successes in elections, such as in Watlington in Kings Lynn. We are pleased to welcome them all to their true home.

We are now happy to be subsidizing yet another east European country! On 1<sup>st</sup> July country number 28 **Croatia** committed sovereign hari-kari and officially joined the EU, and amazingly is hoping to join the Euro soon. Do the leaders of such countries really believe these are two good moves? They must have enjoyed their time as part of a communist state to wish to repeat the experience in the EU, and think the recent catastrophic events around the Euro are just a passing blimp soon to be history. There are none so blind....

The **E-Unit** reports that crucial hearings on the eurozone's **bail-out policies** at Germany's top court in the last week of June could set in motion events that force Germany's withdrawal from the euro, a leading judge has warned. Udo di Fabio, the constitutional court's euro expert until last year, said the explosive case on the legality of the European Monetary Union rescue machinery could provoke a showdown between Germany and the European Central Bank (ECB) and ultimately cause the collapse of monetary union. We await events with hope but low expectations.

Italy's former Prime Minister **Silvio Berlusconi** said recently, "*We need to tell those gentlemen [in Brussels],*" [How polite but is that a slight against Merkel?] "*We are in this situation because of your damn austerity policies. From now on, you can forget about the fiscal pact and the deficit limit of 3% of GDP. Do you want to throw us out of the single currency? Go ahead. Do you want to throw us out of the EU? Well, we'd like to remind you that we pay*

€18bn a year [into the EU budget] and only get €10bn back'. Who would throw us out?" You could almost like a chap for saying that – in this case perhaps not! He has two appeals left against his rape conviction.

Germany is threatening to reduce or even close down **car production** in France, Italy and the UK if the EU does not lower its expectations regarding carbon emissions. For example this would affect BMW who make the Mini in the UK. The loss of jobs could be considerable in the UK, at a time of high unemployment. The threat could drive such jobs out of the EU altogether. The EU is reviewing the emissions early in July, hence the current pressure.

A word of warning. Steer clear of the organisation called **Hope Not Hate** [HNN]. It purports to be an organisation to counter racism and fascism. However it has been revealed that it was set up in 2004 with government finance via the Department of Communities and Local Government to bash the smaller anti-EU parties, initially the BNP and the EDL. It is thought their attention is now being directed at UKIP, and may be behind the recent Daily Mirror attack on our leader Nigel Farage. It is believed that if our leadership does not do as they request the party will be ground down and annihilated as indeed seemed to happen to the BNP. Perhaps their name should be Hate Not Hope. Please ignore their utterances, stay united and make their job as hard as possible.

Regrettably **Jeremy Nieboer** is deeply immersed in his work at present and we are sorry that he is unable to write for you this month. We hope the pressure on his time abates in time for next month's edition.

This does give us the opportunity to add material for which we might not usually have room. We are pleased that our readership has increased steeply in the last year or so. There are one or two subjects of which new members may not be aware so the major one is once again covered here. We apologise if you have previously read of this subject but we feel our new readers should be given the opportunity to see something which explains with great clarity the extraordinary actions of our lord and masters. It is the **Frankfurt School 1928 Manifesto of Cultural Marxism**.

We would advise if you have access to the web that you Google this for a fuller picture. However we hope to give you a flavour of this subject which so critical to both our present circumstances and to our future. The Frankfurt School was a Marxist organisation based in Germany in the 1920's and 30's. Its aims were to destroy the way of life in non-communist countries, including the break-up of the family unit, using mass manipulation and control of the populace. The group of scholars involved in this movement included over a period of years Theodor W. Adorno, Max Horkheimer, Ernst Bloch, Walter Benjamin, Erich Fromm, Herbert Marcuse, Wolfgang Fritz Haug and Jürgen Habermas. The manifesto outlined their intended methods to achieve their stated aims. These included:

- 1) The creation of racism offences.
- 2) Continual change to create confusion.
- 3) The teaching of sex and homosexuality to children.
- 4) The undermining of schools' and teachers' authority.
- 5) Huge immigration to destroy identity.
- 6) The promotion of excessive drinking.
- 7) Emptying of churches.
- 8) An unreliable legal system with bias against victims of crime.
- 9) Dependency on the state or state benefits.
- 10) Control and dumbing down of media.
- 11) Encouraging the breakdown of the family.

Every single one of these is now commonplace in our society, and indeed in most 'free' countries of the world. The politicians can not be unaware of this manifesto, so it must follow that they are following a communist ideal, leading us to what? Is the much mentioned New World Order just another name for communism?

## What the media is saying:

- **Reuters** reports that at a meeting of EU ambassadors Germany blocked the opening of a new chapter in Turkey's EU membership talks. Turkey's EU minister Egemen Bagis responded by telling reporters that "If Mrs Merkel looks into it she will see that those who mess about with Turkey do not have an auspicious end."
- **Open Europe** says French-based NGO Attac told German daily *Suddeutsche Zeitung* that €160bn out of €207bn of EU bailout money for Greece is earmarked for banks and wealthy investors. The NGO's Lisa Mittendrein said the "widespread belief" that EU rescues are designed to help ordinary people "is no longer tenable."
- **According to an ECA press release** The European Court of Auditors has concluded that the €1bn of EU aid to Egypt over the last seven years under the European Neighbourhood Policy has been "well-intentioned, but ineffective" in terms of improving human rights and democracy.
- **The Financial Transaction Tax** which eleven EU members were due to implement in January 2014 now looks set to be delayed by at least six months after the states failed to reach an agreement over key aspects of the tax's scope. So says the **Dow Jones**.
