Britain's "Special Status"

The Prime Minister has published details of the UK's "Special Status" within the EU. As yet, it has not been listed for an EU debate or vote by either the EU Council or Parliament. **This means the "Special Status" will not be enshrined in EU law before the Referendum on 23rd June.** The EU has until early 2017 to ratify (or reject) the "Special Status" proposals, which means we cannot be certain of the outcome.
