In Poole, just two days later, Rev. David Price moderated a debate featuring Sir Graham Watson and Robin Grey in St. John's Church, Ashley Road. Both speakers answered many questions from the audience that helped decision making for those present.

From the desk of David Darling, Chairman, **Dorset OUT:**

Dorset public confidence is wavering in many of the *opinions* (not facts) in the media, being expressed by individuals, groups with special interests and agendas. Add to this the political views which are divided even among both Labour and Conservative Party Members of Parliament. Dorset OUT believes this referendum is not a Party Political decision. It is a decision for you, the voters.

Most of the high profile arguments are currently centred on forecasting the economics of BREXIT. Equally qualified economists of both sides proclaim differing benefits. Rarely do all economists agree on any forecasts. We are often left wondering if it is a case of 'who pays the Piper, calls the tune'.

A wise man once said "Ask 10 economists for a forecast, and you will get at least 12 different predictions."

If we consider our own government forecasts, we only have to look at how often they need changing, to realise how right the 'wise man' is!!

Dorset OUT volunteers organise public meetings and can often be seen on the streets of the main centres in our County. Most of the questions we get from voters who need answers to help in making a decision, relate to immigration, border control, and who runs our country. These are questions we can answer, with facts from official documents published by HM Government and the European Union.

Dorset OUT supporters want most of what the 'Remain in the EU' supporters want. **Dorset OUT** wants to trade with Europe, to be friends with Europe, to exchange information and work with all the countries of Europe for our mutual benefit, security, peace, and prosperity.

What **Dorset OUT** does not want is to be part of a Political Union. We do not want our British Parliamentary Laws to be overruled by a European Court outside of our country. Nor do we wish to be one of a Federated States of Europe, or to lose our Sterling Currency.

The European Union has a plan to complete the political and monetary Union by 2025, It is called the Five President's Report, and was published in June 2015. It is available from a link on the **Dorset OUT** website, or at:

Our Government believes we should remain in a 'Reformed' European Union. The EU will NOT be reformed before 23rd June 2016. If Britain votes to 'Remain in the European Union', the unelected EU Commissioners will probably assume that the vote outcome is a decision to accept the published plans for the future of the EU. N.B. 'Remain' does not mean that the EU will remain as it is.

On a wall at the Visitor Centre at the EU Headquarters in Brussels is a plaque that reads:

'National sovereignty is the root cause of most of the evils of our time. The only remedy to this evil is the Federal Union of the peoples.'
